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PROGRAM OBJECTIVES  
2003-2008

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Pattonville School District's Comprehensive School Improvement Plan (CSIP) states in Goal 1 that students will demonstrate significant improvement in their understanding and application of the Show-Me Standards. To this end and more specifically stated in strategy 7, "library resources [will] support student inquiry and understanding of the Show-Me Standards."

The program objectives of Library Media Services are to...

1. Meet the highest levels of Missouri School Improvement Program (MSIP) standards and the *Standards for Missouri Library Media Centers (1996)*.
  - a. Maintain present level of funding for library collections, with allowances for increases in the average book price.
  - b. Select new library materials, according to district policy, to meet collection standards.
  - c. Deselect library materials, according to district policy, to meet collection standards.
  - d. Monthly (2002-2007) review of specific areas of the library collections (see Collection Development plans for details).
  - e. Report circulation data annually as evidence of collection improvement.
  - f. Promote the use of newly purchased materials in a timely fashion.
  
2. Articulate and evaluate the integration of information literacy within the Communication Arts, Science and Social Studies curricula.
  - a. Articulate *Library and Research Instruction Integration Overview* with principals and classroom teachers.
  - b. Develop instructional units that meet specific learning objectives.
  - c. Effectively collaborate with classroom teachers on learning and instruction.
  
3. Develop and successfully implement a district summer reading program.
